Implementation of MTC Submission for Steel Imports

Background

- Global oversupply has increased unfairly traded steel imports, with inaccurate declarations on the rise.
- Accurate import data is essential for policy-making, trade agreement compliance, and responses to unfair trade practices.

Implementation Plan

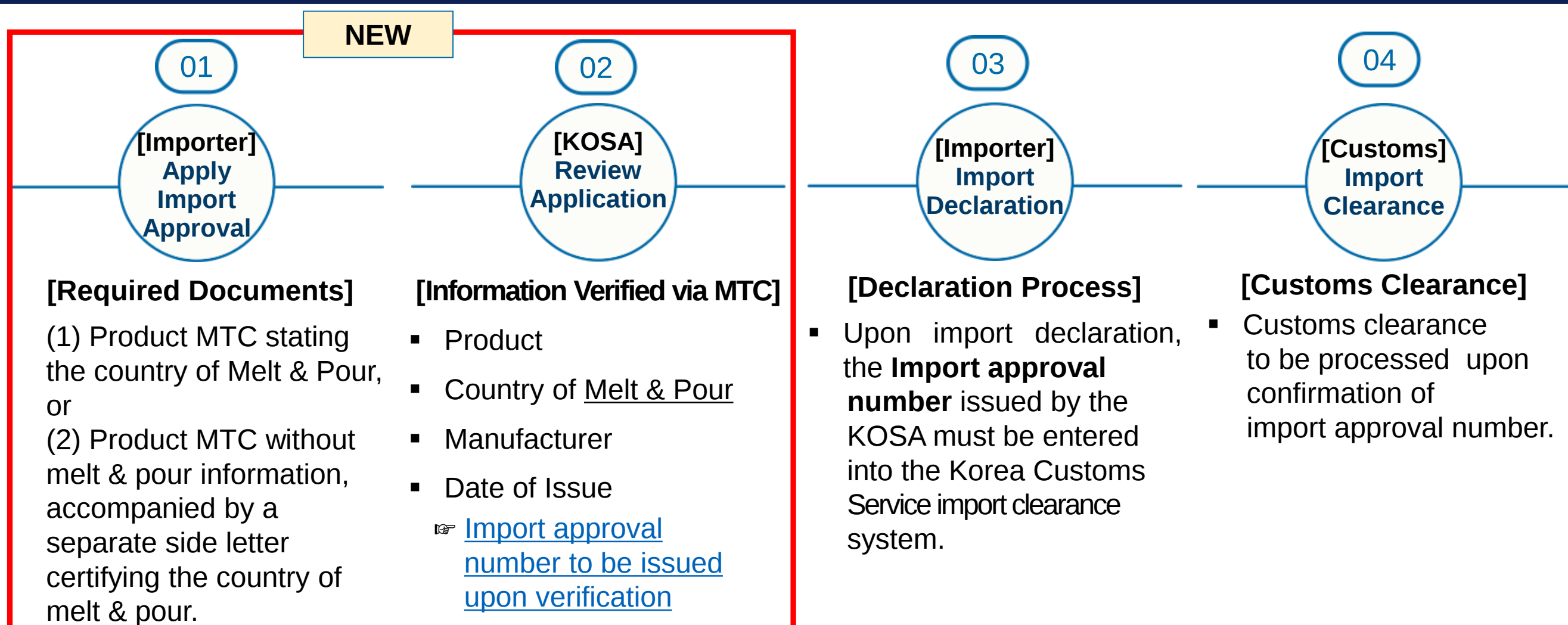
- Article 16 of the Enforcement Decree of the Foreign Trade Act (Restrictions on Imports/Exports) has been amended to introduce a new provision on control of steel-related items.
- Guidelines to be established under the Enforcement Rules of the Foreign Trade Act and the Notice on Export and Import (Article 6, Restricted Import Items), with implementation scheduled for July, 2026.

Implementation of MTC Submission for Steel Imports

Process

- Import Approval Application → Review and Approval of the application → Import Declaration → Clearance and Customs Release.
